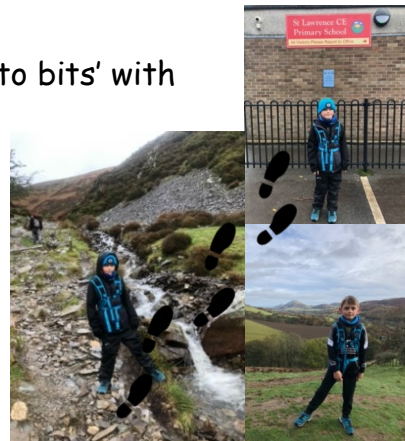
Well done Louie!
