<u> Governor Update - Summer Term</u>

This half term is always a busy one, and during the next three weeks governors will meet for the final full governing body meeting and curriculum meeting of term, as well as being in school for the pupil voice survey and to receive responses from the parent survey. It is a busy but enjoyable end of term, with a positive OFSTED report on it's way too. I'd like to take this opportunity to thank all the staff who go above and beyond every day for the school, not just when inspectors are in. We see it, and we thank you. The staff have shown huge resilience and flexibility as they have adapted to a structure changed by budget restraints. With the budget now balanced and numbers more stable with our newly agreed published admissions number, September sees a return to a more manageable structure.

The role of a governor was perfectly summed up for me at some training I attended this term, I was reminded a Governor should be "eyes on but hands off". Governors should have an oversight of what is happening in school and a duty to question why decisions are made, if they are the best option and how decisions improve outcomes for all children. Governing boards are ever evolving and ours is made up of a mix with some new to the role bringing a fresh pair of eyes, and some who have been doing their role for many years bringing experience and wisdom. This term we are saying a fond farewell to one such experienced governor, Rob Davis, who came to governing as a parent governor on a four-year term of office, staying for years after he no longer had children at the school! 
