A message from our Chair of Governors

Do you know what the largest volunteer force in England is? I guessed at scouts, but with over 250,000 school governors, it's the education service.

Governors aren't always visible to parents or present in the everyday life of a school but their role is important. Governors help to monitor the school's performance, both financial and academic, as well as helping to set the school's vision and holding leaders to account.

We have 12 governors on our board, mostly standing for a 4 year term. Alongside parent governors we have Foundation Governors from the parish to ensure our Christian ethos is carried through everything we do, Community Governors who can be anyone from the local community over age 18, and a Local Authority governor who is put forward by the Local Authority. With varied backgrounds, ages and careers everyone brings a different view and we all volunteer for different reasons.
